

**MINUTES**  
**SPECIAL CALLED MEETING**  
**JANUARY 23, 2018**

Welcome and call to order by Mayor Randy Horton

Discussion: Council seat left open by the resignation of Nathan George.

Motion: Mark Tripp. Let's leave it open until a deadline of February 2 to give people time to send in their letters of interest. Then set a meeting for Monday February 5, the day before the agenda meeting on that Tuesday so we can do the interviews.
